SINGLE SIGN-ON ENABLED FOR QUALTRICS

Qualtrics can now be accessed through Ramapo's single sign-on (SSO)! Existing users will be redirected to the SSO page to sign in with their Ramapo credentials. New users should <u>submit a ticket</u> to request a Qualtrics account.

SSO will not work with group/department email address, so these users should select "Qualtrics sign in page" to continue logging into their Qualtrics account.

TURNITIN: AI DETECTION

The AI detection feature has been reinstated in Turnitin! Moving forward, all Turnitin assignments you generate will feature the AI writing indicator in the side panel of the Similarity Report. Please note that this indicator will not appear in previous assignments.
