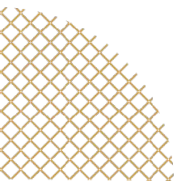

What is First-Generation?

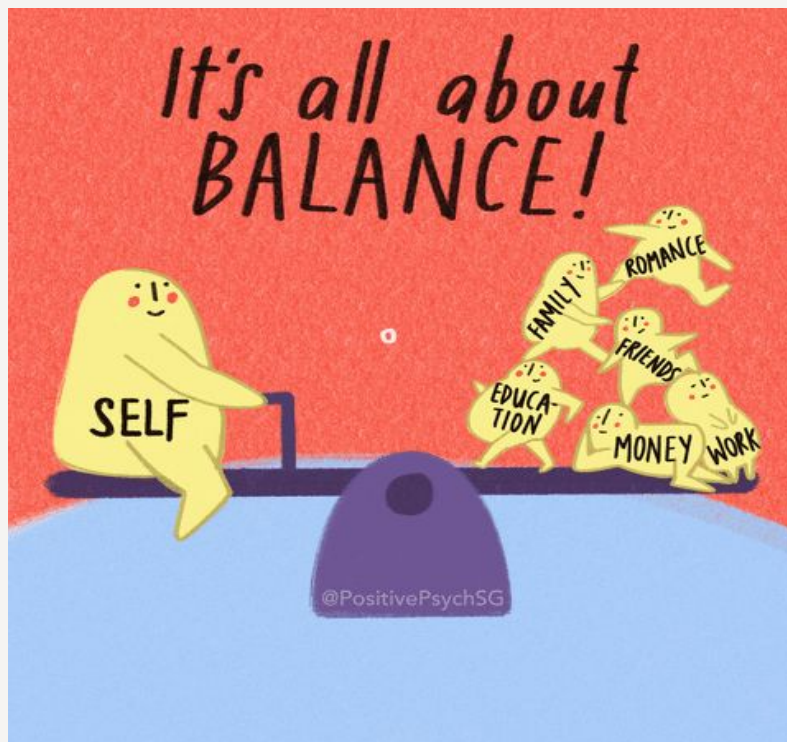
Ramapo College of New Jersey defines a first-generation student as a student where neither parent(s) nor legal guardian(s) have completed a bachelor's degree in the U.S.

About 45% of the incoming first-year class identify as first-generation!

- STEM Center & Tutoring



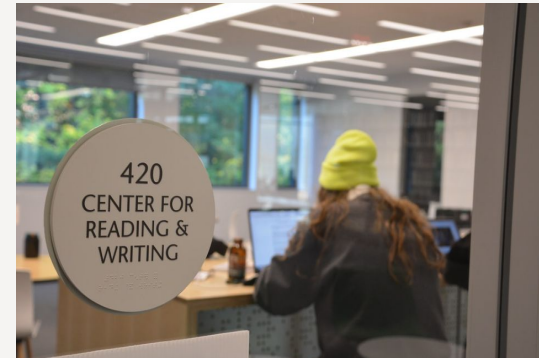
Time Management

- *Remind your student* that for every 1 hour a student spends in class, 2 hours should be set aside for studying/completing assignments.
- Students taking a full-time load of 16 credits should set aside about 32 hours per week.
- *Encourage your student* to familiarize themselves with the syllabi for their courses.



Center for Reading & Writing

- Offers one-on-one consulting sessions in writing and reading to students on all academic levels, both virtually and in-person.
- Assists in all stages of the writing process, from brainstorming to polishing final papers.
- Provides reading strategies for difficult texts.
- Facilitate a wide variety of workshops from study skills to MLA, APA, and Chicago documentation styles.



The STEM Center

- Walk-in tutoring and tutoring by appointment in many of the 1st and 2nd year courses for the following majors:
 - Math
 - Biology
 - Chemistry
 - Physics
 - Computer/Data Science
- Peer tutors chosen by professors.
- STEM professional staff support for student success.
- STEM workshops offered.
- STEM community building events.

Scholarships for students affiliated with the Office of Specialized Services (OSS) are now open for applications until 6/24/24.

Most other scholarships will open for applications in mid-August. Please check the website and Daily Digest for updates.

To be considered for any scholarship award, students must complete a general application.

The application process has been streamlined, and you will be automatically matched with scholarships for which you are eligible. A general essay is still required, with some scholarships requiring supplemental short essays and/or letters of recommendation.

Scholarships are awarded on a rolling basis throughout both semesters. Due to the volume of applications, you will only be notified if you have been chosen to receive an award.
