

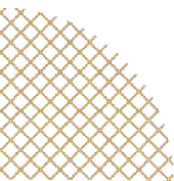

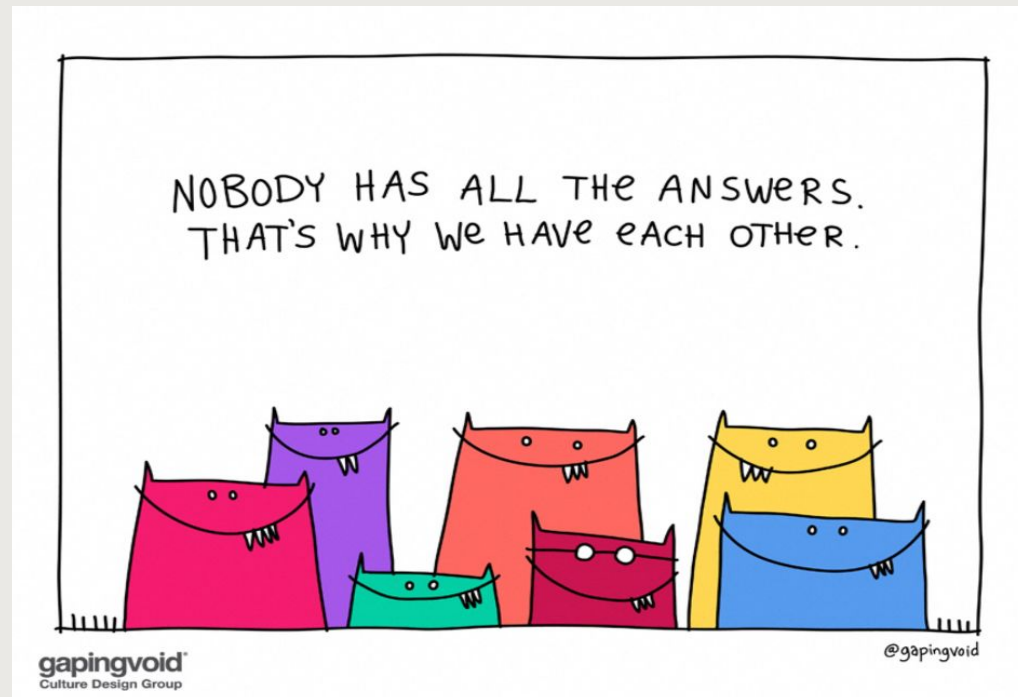

Peer facilitators are experienced students who know the path to success.

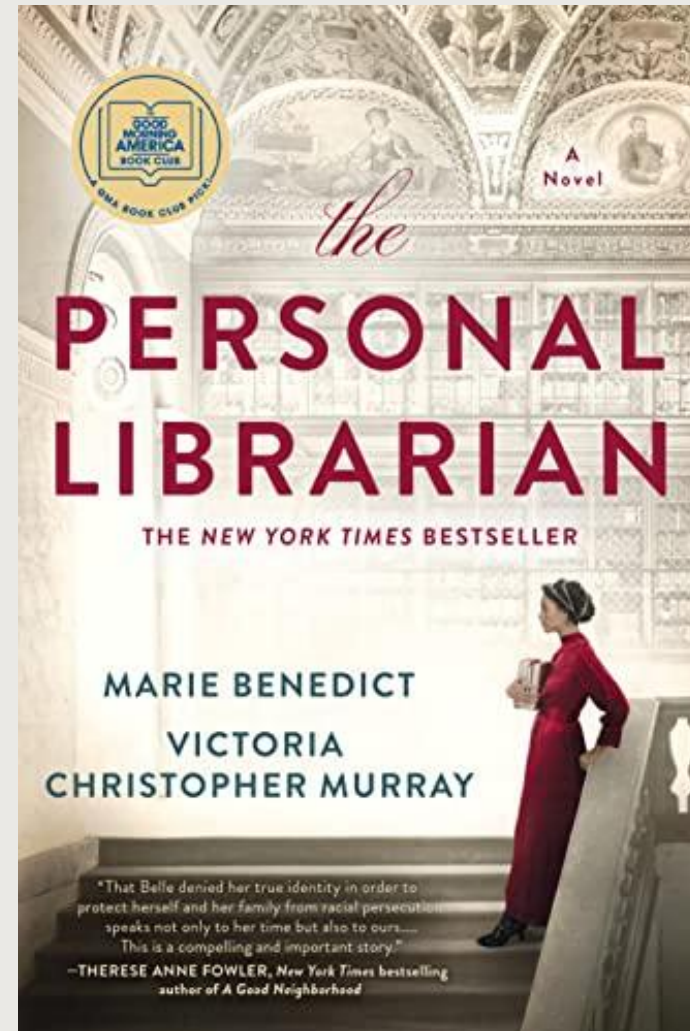
- Peer facilitators pick up where Orientation Leaders leave off.

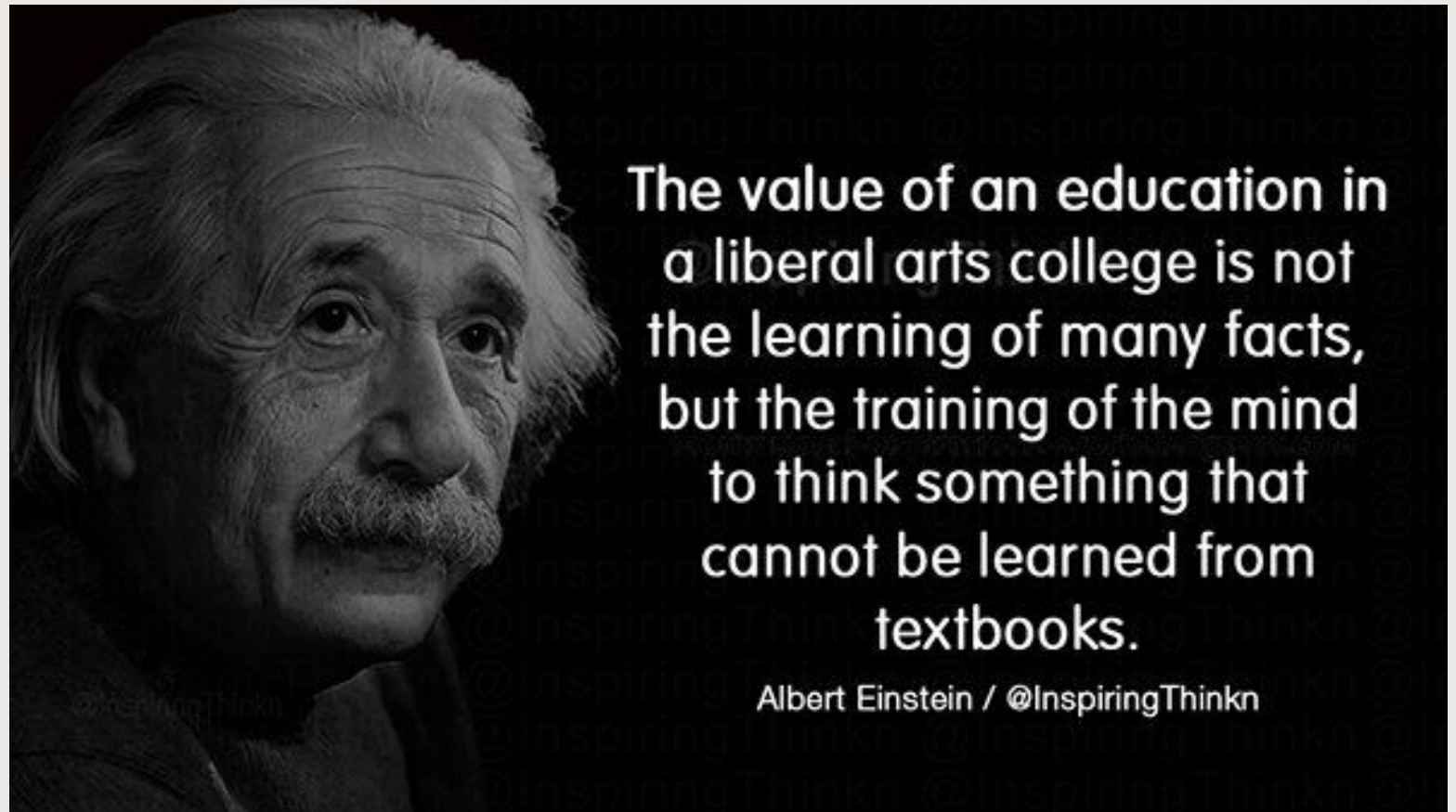
STEM Center


