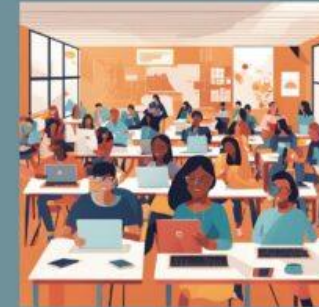
- ***March 12: TechFest at Faculty Development Day***

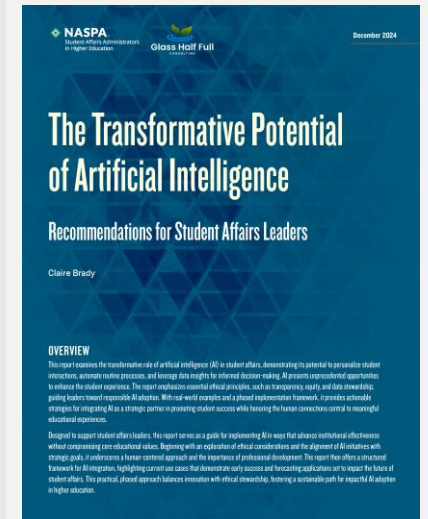
